## 2021 Edets'seèhdzà Studentship Awarded to Aurora College Student Samantha Morandin

Yellowknife (May 27, 2021) - Hotiì ts'eeda and Aurora College are pleased to announce that the 2021 Edets'seèhdzà Studentship Award has been awarded to third-year nursing student Samantha Morandin.

Ms. Morandin is the fourth student supported through the Edets'seèhdzà Studentship since its launch in 2019. The studentship supports an Aurora College student to be involved in health research during their studies through a \$20,000 stipend. The award is funded by Hotiì ts'eeda and provided through partnership between Hotiì ts'eeda and Aurora College, Edets'seèhdzà (eh-DEY-tsay-zah) means "stepping forward to challenge yourself" in the Tłjcho language.

Ms. Morandin plans to graduate with her Bachelor of Science in Nursing in 2022 and begin her nursing career in the North. She is committed to holistic health care, and hopes to use this opportunity to learn more about Indigenous health, traditions, medicines and ways of healing in order to provide superior culturally safe nursing care.
